**TASTING NOTES**

Intense flavors of boysenberry and dried cherry combine with spicy white pepper and sage notes. Full-bodied with a rich, silky mouthfeel and well-structured tannins that give way to a long and supple finish.

**WINEMAKING**

Dry Creek Valley produces wines with densely-concentrated character and rich flavor. The best Zinfandel is grown in the benchlands, where dry rocky soils provide the perfect terroir.

The 2014 vintage had a long and dry growing season with mild temperatures making for nearly perfect conditions for producing superior Zinfandel. Harvest of our Dry Creek Zinfandel began September 29<sup>th</sup> and lasted until mid-October with each vineyard being picked after it reached its maximum flavor.

The fruit was then crushed and destemmed before being cold soaked for 48 hours. After fermentation began, the wines were kept on the skins for three weeks. The young wine was pressed and settled before transfer into American and French oak barrels for 19 months. After aging was complete, our finest quality barrels were carefully selected and blended for bottling.

**FOOD PAIRINGS**

The zesty nature of this rich and full-flavored Zinfandel allows it to be an excellent accompaniment to full flavored dishes such as a hearty lasagna, BBQ ribs or pizza on the grill.
